



# Ring of Numbers | Arrange the numbers 1 through 11 in the

# Nine • Dot • Cross


Using only four straight lines, and without lifting your pencil from the paper, cross over all nine dots. You may not retrace a line, but you may cross it.



Complete the word square below using four words that mean: ready for action, pass along, woods path, and fashion. Words go across and up and down.




Can you find the seven state names? To spell out a state, keep moving from one letter to the next in any direction—up, down, across, or diagonally. You may move in several different directions for each word.


