When Your Class Begins

The winter quarter typically includes significant changes in weather. Be prepared with a place where children can hang coats and lay wet items. Remind parents to write names on clothing items.

Be aware of health issues too. Watch for children who display cold or flu symptoms. Have tissues and wet wipes available. (See the health tips included on the Resources CD printable file Classroom Safety.)

As your children come in from the cold outdoors, greet them with the warmth of Jesus' love. His love can brighten and warm any gloomy or cold dav.

Unit 3 Bible Memory Activities

Make copies of the Unit 3 Bible Memory poster and Bible Memory motions from the Resources CD printable files. Place them where you can refer to them throughout the unit. Make extra copies of the poster for children to color and decorate with stickers.

Sing the unit 3 Bible Memory song, "We Should Love Each Other." As the song is played, teach the Bible Memory motions, also found on the Resources CD.

On a sheet of poster board, write the Bible Memory words, substituting a red heart for the word love. Help children "read" the verse. Talk about why we can use a heart shape to represent the word *love*. Tell children that the words and numbers after the verse are the "address" (where to find the words) of the verse. Emphasize that learning the verse includes learning the address. Add a heart to the poster board with each child's name on it as each one learns to say the verse.

Send home the family letter also found on the CD. Ask parents to reinforce the Bible Memory words each day throughout the week.

The music on the CD is reproducible. Send a CD home with each child so parents can sing the songs with their children all week long!

Unit 3 Theme Project

Cut out different sizes and colors of paper hearts. Let each child select several hearts and glue them to a 9" x 12" poster board, creating a poster to give to someone. Help children print the Bible Memory on their posters. Have them draw pictures of things they like about the people who will receive the posters. Encourage children to consider giving their posters to ministry leaders. Place each poster in a 10" x 13" envelope and help children add "to" and "from" lines. Adding glitter or stickers will make the posters even more fun. Children can deliver their poster cards on the last Sunday of the quarter.

Allergy Notice

Before class, print and fill out the Allergy Notice from the Resources CD for each snack that is served. Post it visibly for parents to take note. And always check your own children's information.

Mark name tags so volunteers can easily identify dietary needs.
