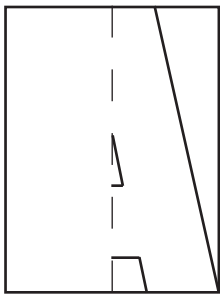


Patterns for Cutting Letters and Numbers

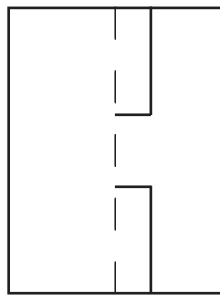

Have or cut all pieces of paper the same size before you begin. Corners may be rounded, if you prefer.

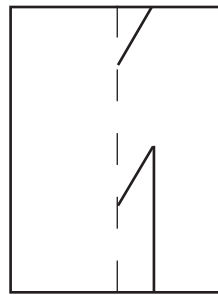
On a vertical fold, cut out these letters or this number.



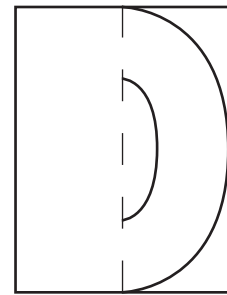
